DISCOUNT FOR PAYING SCHOOL FEES IN FULL

If you pay the Annual Tuition Fee in full by Friday, 30 January 2026 you will receive a \$520 discount.

PAYMENT TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Families can make payments via the Parent Portal or by BPAY. School fees are payable in four termly instalments, with each instalment due by the first day of the respective term.

All fees and charges must be paid on or before the following dates:

1 st instalment (1/4 of the total fees and charges invoiced)	Tuesday, 27 January, 2026
2 nd instalment (1/4 of the total fees and charges invoiced)	Monday, 20 April, 2026
3 rd instalment (1/4 of the total fees and charges invoiced)	Monday, 20 July, 2026
4 th instalment (1/4 of the total fees and charges invoiced)	Monday, 12 October 2026

Payment plans are also available through the Parent Portal. All fees and charges will be spread equally across the selected plan. For monthly, fortnightly or weekly plans, the final payment must be completed by 31 October 2026.

Card payments will incur a surcharge. No surcharge is applied to payments linked to a bank account.

RETURNED PAYMENTS AND UNPAID FEES

If any scheduled payment is returned, the following charges will apply for each returned payment:

- charge by bank: \$33 (to cover their costs relating to returned payment).
- charge by the College: \$100 (to cover our administration costs relating to returned payment).

If the fees and charges invoiced are not paid by the due date:

- The debt outstanding may be referred to an external debt collection agency.
- Legal action may be taken to recover the debt.
- The Principal may suspend or terminate the student's enrolment.

Families experiencing temporary financial difficulties in meeting scheduled payment dates must email the Finance office early (at least 14 working days before the payment due date) at fees@saintaug.nsw.edu.au to discuss and agree on a revised plan.

STUDENT LEAVING

Parents/Guardians must give one term's notice in writing or by email to the College Registrar to withdraw their son from the College. If one term's notice is not received by the College, school fees for one term will be charged.
